

## THERE ARE DIFFERENCES IN DEFINITIONS AND INTERPRETATIONS

### COMPARE THE FOLLOWING WITH SCRIPTURE:

The Second Adam work of Christ was to do away with the law of sin and death for the whole cosmos and especially for those who believe and receive Jesus. Romans 8:2,21

The substitutionary, Second Adam, sacrifice of Christ condemns sin because Jesus was sinless.  
Romans 8:3

The finished work of Christ on the Cross sentences sin to removal. John 1:29

The sinless death of Christ makes salvation possible for all who will receive it. Romans 5:18,19

The resurrected Christ imparts eternal life to those who believe and receive the gift through repentance and faith. We are saved by His life. Romans 5:10

Election of God occurs after regeneration in Christ and is to holiness and service. Eph. 1:4,5

Predestination is the purpose of God to complete salvation for those who are of readiness of mind to receive the gift of eternal life in Christ. Ephesians 1:11-14

To miss eternal life is to perish and be separated from God for all eternity. John 3:16

Correct motivation for following Jesus is to have a love relationship with God through Christ and to know God intimately under the realization of personal sin and the great love of God in removing sin for those who believe. John 17:3 John 1:29
