

BIBLE LESSONS FOR CHILDREN (ONE)

Parable Mark 12:1-9 God allowed men to harvest fruit.

God sent His servants to earth to inspect and receive some of the fruit.

Men beat some of God's servants and killed others.

God sent His Son but men killed Him also.

God says, "Obey your parents." When you disobey, your sin is against God.

Sin is always against God. Sin hates God. Sin calls God a liar.

My sin and your sin abused Jesus while He was on the Cross. Our sin killed Jesus.

Jesus is God. All sin is against God.

Jesus was conscious of our sin being against Him. All our sin was laid on Jesus.

Jesus died because of our sin.

Jesus died to condemn sin.

The Law of Sin and Death says, "If you sin, you die."

But Jesus never sinned. Sin killed Jesus. Sin is guilty of breaking God's Law.

Sin is condemned in the court of heaven for killing the Holy Son of God.

Sin is sentenced to removal from all creation.

Jesus is resurrected with all power and authority to remove sin.

Jesus died to take away our sin.

Believe in Jesus for your sin removal.

The process of sin removal begins when you call upon Jesus to save you.

Sin removal happens daily as you obey God. God promises to complete His work of sin removal.

When you reach heaven, you will be sinless.

What replaces sin in your life? Righteous actions led by the Spirit who lives in you replaces sin.
