

CHRIST PAID THE PRICE FOR REDEEMING ALL CREATION FROM SIN AND DEATH

Christ paying the price for sin removal by dying on the cross is just the prerequisite for our salvation.

Christ paying the price by itself does not save a single person. The cross guarantees the finished work of redemption. Christ has the right to remove sin and death. Christ nailed the Law of Sin and Death to the cross. Christ fulfills the Law of the Covenant and accomplishes what the Law could not do. Christ defeated sin, death, and all wickedness. **Colossians 2:14,15 Romans 8:2,3**

The Law of Sin and Death was given to Adam. The Law of the Covenant was given through Moses.

What action of Jesus Christ saves us?

Death, Resurrection, Regeneration of believers, Indwelling Spirit in believers, Sanctification, Glorification, Justification: Jesus was delivered up for our offenses, and was raised again for our justification.

Romans 4:25 To justify means Christ gives a good answer as to why you have eternal life.

Our salvation is about our regeneration, justification, sanctification, and glorification. Christ paying the price for sin removal accomplishes none of these while He was still on the cross. The resurrected Christ saves us by His life when we believe in Him. **Romans 5:10b** We shall be saved by His life.

Jesus changes the believing sinner. The change He makes in us justifies our receiving eternal life.

Titus 3:5b He saved us, by the washing of regeneration, and renewing of the Holy Spirit.

Romans 3:23 presents us with two problems. We have sinned and we come short of the glory of God.

Our salvation addresses both of these problems. Our sin must be dealt with and we must be glorified.

Romans 4 tells us how sin is overcome by the death and resurrection of Jesus for our justification.

Romans 5 tells us that justification is provisional. Only those who believe are justified.

Romans 6-8:16 tells us how we live in the presence of sin with power over sin.

Roman 8:17-39 tells us we will be glorified, adopted, and experience the redemption of our body.

Christ paying the price for sin removal does not save anyone. Christ nailing the Law of Sin and Death to the Cross does not save anyone. Christ paying the price is the prerequisite for redemption and for salvation. You must be born again. Those who believe in Jesus for sin removal and future glorification receive regeneration which begins our new life in Him.
