

DEATH THAT COMES FROM THE RESULT OF SIN

Physical death comes to all except those who are part of the Rapture of the Church.

Hebrews 9:27 People are destined to die once and then the judgment.

Spiritual death comes to all accountable people until they are born again.

Ephesians 2:1 And you hath God made alive, who were dead (spiritually) in trespasses and sins.

The Second Death comes to all accountable people who die physically without new birth in Jesus.

Revelation 20: 13b-15 And all men (not found in the book of life) were judged according to their works. And death and hades were cast into the lake of fire. This is the second death. And whosoever was not found written in the book of life was cast into the lake of fire.

The Sacrificial Death of Jesus at the Cross was for sin's removal and so that believers may live in righteous works initiated and empowered by the Spirit.

Hebrews 9:14 How much more shall the blood of Christ, who through the eternal Spirit offered Himself without spot to God, purge your conscience from dead works to serve the living God?

Ephesians 1:7 In whom we have redemption through His blood, the forgiveness of sins (sin removal) according to the riches of His grace.

Jesus was our substitute representative acting on behalf of humanity to defeat sin, death, and Satan. (God allowed sin to kill Jesus and this was the most atrocious thing because Jesus was sinless.)

Romans 5:18 By the offense of one, judgment came upon all men to condemnation; even so by the righteousness of one Man, the free gift came upon all men unto justification of life.

Adam (our representative) brought judgment, Christ (our representative) brings righteousness to all who believe and receive Him. Jesus is humanity's God given substitute in place of Adam.

God sent His own Son in the likeness of sinful flesh, and for sin's removal, condemned sin to execution. Jesus died sinless and rose with all authority to remove sin from believers making them new creations in Christ.

2 Corinthians 5:17 Therefore if any man be in Christ, he is a new creature: old things have passed away; all things have become new.

Believers have been reconciled to God by being changed to new creations in Christ.

2 Corinthians 5:18 And all things are of God, who hath reconciled us to Himself by Jesus Christ, and has given to us the ministry of reconciliation.

The righteousness of God (His right to take away our sin and give us eternal life) is by the faith of Jesus Christ (His faithfulness to die sinless) unto all and upon all those that believe in Christ. The condemnation of sin by the sinless death of Jesus, gives Him the right to take away our sin and produce righteous actions within us.

Romans 8:3b God, sending His own Son in the likeness of sinful flesh, and for sin's removal, condemned sin in the flesh.

Sin is therefore condemned to extermination and extinction.

Revelation 21:4 And God shall wipe away all tears from their eyes; and there shall be no more death, neither sorrow, nor crying, neither shall there be any more pain: for the former things are passed away.
