

JUSTIFICATIONS FOUND IN SCRIPTURE

Jesus is justified in giving eternal life to those who believe and receive Him by His sinless death and vindicated by His resurrection. The sinless death of Jesus condemned sin to the utmost. Sin is sentenced to removal from all creation. Jesus is the Righteous One, the Second Adam, who lived and died sinless. Jesus will judge all things.

Romans 1:3-6 Concerning His Son Jesus Christ our Lord, which was made of the seed of David according to the flesh; And declared to be the Son of God with power, according to the Spirit of holiness, by the resurrection from the dead: By whom we have received grace and apostleship, for obedience to the faith among all nations, for His name: Among whom are ye also the called of Jesus Christ.

1 Timothy 3:16 And without controversy great is the mystery of godliness: God was manifest in the flesh, justified in the Spirit, seen of angels, preached unto the Gentiles, believed in the world, received up into glory.

Believers are justified freely by His grace through the redemption that came by Christ Jesus.

Romans 3:22 This righteousness from God comes through faith in Jesus Christ to all who believe.

Belief precedes regeneration. Redemption is the end result of regeneration and is the believer's death to sin and new life in Christ.

The believer's justification for eternal life is brought about by their death to sin and newness of life in Christ. **Romans 6:1-23**

We are saved by His life. Jesus was raised to life for our justification so that His life may be lived out in us. **Romans 5:9,10 Romans 4:25**

We are justified through our faith in Him and this gives us peace with God. **Rom. 5:1**

God the Father presented Jesus as a sacrifice to bring about the condemnation of sin.
