

THE FALSE JESUS IS BEING TAUGHT IN SOME CHURCHES

The false Jesus is killed by God so that God can be appeased and forgive sinners. This is a false teaching concerning God. God needs nothing. God does not need to be appeased. God freely forgives and does not need to kill Jesus in our place in order to forgive us.

The True Jesus can be found in Scripture but not in some pulpits of America. The following description of God the Father and Jesus the Son shows that They are perfectly aligned in Their work to rescue people from sin.

God allowed sin and sinful men to kill sinless Jesus. God did not angrily pour His wrath upon His Son and kill Him in our place. God did not transfer our sin to Jesus and kill Him to appease His wrath against sin. God has no need of being appeased of His wrath against sin. God has no need of killing Jesus in our place so that He can justly forgive us our sin. God freely forgives our sin without any payment for the sin.

The false Jesus became sin and was killed by an angry God to appease His wrath against sin and pay the penalty for sin.

Jesus did not become sin in any form or fashion. Jesus did not pay the penalty for our sin because the penalty for sinners who reject God is eternal separation from God. Jesus became the sin offering and sin condemned itself by its atrocious act of killing the very Son of God. Romans 8:3 2 Cor. 5:21

Jesus, “who bore our sin” does not mean that Jesus became a sinner vicariously in our place. Bore means to be lifted up, carried, and tolerated. Jesus lifted up sin to its utter condemnation for killing the suffering, sinless Man. All sin is condemned to extinction because of the physical death of sinless Jesus. Jesus was not being punished by God in our place. While Jesus was on the cross He only saved one man, a repentant sinner. All the elect were not saved while Jesus was on the cross. Jesus’ death does not in itself save anyone. Jesus’ death made salvation possible. Repentant sinners are saved by His life which enters into the believer at regeneration. Repentant sinners who call upon Jesus to save them are saved at the moment they call. They were not saved 2000 years ago when Jesus died.

1 Peter 2:22-25 Romans 10:13 Romans 4:24,25 For us who believe in Jesus, grace abounds.

The false Jesus saved people at the cross 2000 years ago. That is why Calvinist's preach a limited atonement. They believe Jesus' death saved all who will be saved. So they believe salvation by His death had to be limited to only the elect before the foundation of the world. Otherwise all people would be saved by His death. Thus they believe in a limited salvation produced by the death of Christ. David Platt, R.C. Sproul, John Macarthur, and others preach this in their churches and in their books. They have a wrong definition of election, atonement, and justification.

The real Jesus saves us by His resurrection life infused in us at conversion. He lives in us replacing sin with righteous actions. We were not saved at the cross. We were saved when we cooperated with Holy Spirit conviction and received Jesus as our Lord and Savior. Romans 5:17

Believers are infused with the spiritual blood of Jesus Christ, the very resurrected life of Jesus coming to live in the born again new creation in Christ. The Spirit of Christ seals the believer with eternal life and indwells the believer permanently for all eternity.

John Calvin, Martin Luther, and Jacob Arminius taught the false Jesus which came from Catholicism, especially Augustinian teachings. I have heard David Platt and R.C. Sproul (followers of John Calvin) preaching sermons proclaiming the false Jesus.

It has been shown that when people tolerate the false Jesus, they will finally be intolerant of the real Jesus (SBC 2017). See tomwhedbee.com August 17, 2025

The real Jesus is Life giving.

The physical death (blood) of Jesus at the cross makes our salvation possible. His sinless death condemns sin to eventual extermination. Jesus arose with all power to take away sin. The spiritual blood of resurrected Jesus infuses the believer with eternal life making our salvation a reality. We are saved by His life in us. Jesus is the Way, the Truth, and the Life.

Salvation is transformational, a new creation, Christ in me, and born from above.

DO YOU THINK THAT YOU ARE A CALVINIST?

We are not saved by some mystical heavenly application of Jesus' literal physical blood.

We are saved by the infusion of the resurrected life of Jesus into us. We are infused by the spiritual life's blood of the resurrected Jesus. We are saved by the Spirit of Christ living in us. We are sealed, born from above, and regenerated by the Holy Spirit with eternal life after we believe Jesus and receive Jesus.

Calvinism teaches that people must be regenerated before they can believe and receive Jesus. Calvinism teaches that the unsaved have no ability to cooperate with Holy Spirit conviction and be brought to believe and receive Jesus.

Calvinism teaches that you really cannot know that you are saved until you persevere to the end. Calvinism teaches that you can only persevere if you are "elect" before the foundation of the world.

Ephesians chapters 1 and 2 say that those who are "in Christ" are then elected to be holy and blameless in God's sight. Therefore, election happens after a person believes and receives Jesus. "For He chose us "in Him" before the foundation of the world to be holy and blameless before Him in love." Ephesians 1:4 God chose before creation that only those who receive Christ, those In Christ, are chosen (elected) for eternal life.

Calvinism teaches that "election to eternal life" happened before the foundation of the world with no consideration to the person's cooperation with the conviction of the Holy Spirit.

Romans chapter 5 teaches that people believe and receive Jesus and are saved to eternal life by the resurrected life of Jesus infused internally. Verse 10 says that we are saved through His life. The physical shed blood of Jesus makes our salvation possible. The infused spiritual blood of resurrected Jesus in us makes us a new creation, born from above, regenerated, and sealed to the day of redemption.

"I have written these things to you who believe in the name of the Son of God, so that you may know that you have eternal life." 1 John 5:13

Therefore, we can know that we have eternal life and it is not dependent upon our faith that we were elected before the foundation of the world. Our faith is in Jesus, not in election.

Calvinism teaches that people are saved by the death of Christ. Calvinism teaches that the death of Jesus was only efficient for the elect of God who were chosen before creation. Calvinism teaches that Jesus only died savingly for a select few (the elect). Calvinism teaches that the death of Jesus 2000 years ago procured the salvation of all who will ever be saved.

The Bible says that people are saved to eternal life by the Life of Christ infused in the believer.

Romans 5-10

The Bible says that people are saved today through their cooperation with Holy Spirit conviction and by believing Jesus and receiving Jesus.

The major points of Calvinism teach the direct opposite of what the Bible teaches. If you think that you are a Calvinist, then you are a threat to the very Gospel of Jesus Christ.

People who think they are Calvinist were deceived by some teacher. Many who think they are Calvinist are not Calvinist at all. Calvinism and Arminianism are both deceptions of God's Word.
