

## THE FULL GOSPEL OF JESUS CHRIST

The sinless death of Jesus condemned sin to the utmost and Jesus arose in defeat of sin, death, and Satan. Adam plunged the world into sin by one act of disobedience. Jesus did one act of righteousness, dying sinless, and has now the right to take away the sins of the world. God allowed sin to kill Jesus so that sin is condemned to its own execution. Romans 5:18

Romans 8:3,21      John 1:29

Jesus died to take away the sins of the world and reconcile cooperating people to God. The sinless death of Jesus and His resurrection gave Him the right to take away sin and rescue people from sin. Romans 5:19

Today, whosoever cooperates with conviction of the Holy Spirit, believes, and receives Jesus for the taking away of their sin, that person receives regeneration and eternal life. The cooperation of the believer must include the genuine desire to be rescued from sin. Those who pray to receive Jesus to gain a ticket out of hell without a desire to be rescued from sin are still lost in their sin.

The sinless death of Jesus was not saving us from God. The sinless death of Jesus made Him the New Adam with the right of reconciling cooperating people to God. The physical, sinless, shed blood of Jesus made provision for all mankind to be reconciled to God. The spiritual, life-giving blood of Jesus must be received into the heart of cooperating people before they can be reconciled to God and have regeneration and eternal life. 1 Timothy 2:4   1 John 2:2 Jesus, who knew no sin, became the offering for sin in that He died a physical death by the hand of sin. Sin is guilty of killing the Son of God. Sin is condemned to removal from all creation because of the cross of Jesus. Jesus arose with victory over sin, death, and Satan.

At 3 pm, Jesus quoted Psalm 22:1, saying, My God, my God, why have You forsaken Me? Jesus is identifying Himself with the crucified, suffering, Messiah. The cross does feel like God is forsaking Him, but Jesus knows that God is not forsaking Him. Psalm 22:24 states that God is not turning His back on Jesus. Jesus knows this Scripture. God watches over the cross not allowing even one bone to be broken. Matthew 27:46 Luke 23:46 John 19:36

Seconds later after 3 pm, Jesus says, Father, into Thy hands I commit My Spirit. This proves that Jesus did not believe that God had forsaken Him.

Jesus paid a high price to be able to rescue humanity from sin. As the sinless Second Adam, Jesus does rescue cooperating people who believe and receive Jesus for their rescue from sin. Jesus was not paying our debt of sin to God so that God could forgive us of our sin. God freely forgives. Ephesians 4:32

Justice does not demand that someone must die in our place in payment for our sins. Justice is satisfied by God changing the believer into a new creation made in the image of Christ.

Regeneration of cooperating believers does save us from the wrath of God. We become holy and blameless in His sight.

To be “in Christ” is the requirement for being chosen to be made in the image of Jesus.

Ephesians 1:4

God’s desire for every person: cooperation with Holy Spirit conviction, believing and receiving Christ, Regeneration in Christ, election to eternal life, predestination to holiness and blamelessness, calling to holiness and service, justification through new creation experienced in sanctification, and then glorification with a new body made in heaven that is totally sinless and totally righteous.
