

## UNBIBLICAL PHRASES THAT LEAD SOME PEOPLE TO BELIEVE IN A FALSE JESUS

Any phrase that leads people to think that Jesus is being punished by God to pay for their sin defeats the purpose of the Gospel of Jesus Christ. It results in the lost man having a false conversion and false security. It results in the saved man compromising with sins he thinks are paid for and thus leads to a defeated life.

The following is a partial list of unbiblical phrases which destroy lives.

Jesus became sin and was punished in our place.

Sin was imputed to Jesus. This concept is not in the Bible.

Jesus died a spiritual death in our place.

Jesus paid the penalty for our sin. (Penal substitution is a wicked deception.)

Jesus was cursed by God in our place.

Jesus was killed by God so that justice could be satisfied.

Jesus experienced the wrath of God in our place.

Jesus took on our guilt of sin.

Jesus paid our debt to sin so that God could forgive us.

Jesus' death satisfied the wrath of God.

The truth of Jesus and the cross is very simple. It is so simple a child can understand.

Jesus died a sinless death, killed by sin, and this sinless physical death defeated sin and condemned sin to eventual extermination. Jesus arose with all power and authority to rescue believers from sin by making them new creations "in Christ". John 3:16; Matthew 28:18; Rom. 8:3

Making the death of Jesus what it is not, leads to false conversions, false assurance of salvation, and defeated lives. If you prayed a prayer to receive Jesus but you have no desire to be changed into a new creation and follow Jesus, you believed in the false Jesus. The false Jesus does not save.

Repentant, cooperative, humble believers are saved by the resurrected life infused into one's life. The death of Jesus gave Jesus the right to save us from sin. His death makes our salvation possible. We are saved by His life in us, His Spirit in us, His infused spiritual blood in us. Jesus is life eternal in us. If His Spirit is not in you, then you have never been born from above. The fruits of the Spirit in your life
